COURSE DETAILS/UNITS AND AIMS

Early Years Education and Care (QCF) prepares learners to work with children between birth and 5 years, with knowledge of children up to 7 years.

The course is delivered on a three day class and two day work placement basis.

Students will be expected to provide evidence and pass all 14 mandatory units.

All units will be internally assessed using a range of methods, including direct observation within the workplace, a portfolio of evidence, written assignments or a task set by CACHE.

SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

Although there are no entry requirements for this qualification, students will be expected to show a genuine interest in children's development and pass the Enhanced Disclosure Check. (DBS)

Students must be prepared to attend the allocated work placements and ensure they are reliable and trustworthy.
