

Re-Submission Policy

MISSION STATEMENT

The purpose of Thomas Becket Catholic School is to realise its vision by being a Catholic School for Excellence. We are committed to the total development of the whole person by means of a continuing journey through learning, personal development, community and worship.

Aims:

Assessment strategy, processes and management underpin an assessment system that:

- Delivers valid and reliable outcomes.
- Follows Edexcel regulations and requirements currently in force for external assessment, where this is appropriate.
- Reflects national standards.
- Leads to the safe certification of learner achievement.

In order to do this, Thomas Becket Will:

Ensure learners, who fit the following criteria, are given the opportunity to submit work to the best of their ability and achieve the best possible grade:

- Students who have failed to achieve one criteria from each unit, which results in them not hitting either a pass, merit or distinction will be allowed to re-submit.
- Students who have been absent for an extended amount of time due to illness or other unforeseen circumstances, which has resulted in them being unable to complete the work in the set time.
- Students will have 7 days in which to re-work the assignment and re-submit work by the date highlighted on the assessment plan which should be evident on the feedback form to the student. Students must also be unsupported by teaching staff in completing this work.
- Students who have failed to achieve two or more criteria for each unit will NOT be given the opportunity to re-submit their work.

This policy will be reviewed every 12 months by the Quality Nominee.
