



# **How to make your Post 16 Options choices**

## **Pathway Choices**

As a Year 11 student at Thomas Becket Catholic School, the time has come for you to take part in planning your programme of study for the next two years. In year 12 you will follow one of the following 3 pathways:

#### **Level 3 - 4 Advanced Level Subjects**

Minimum of 5GCSE's at grades 5A\*-C including English Language and Maths plus any specific subject entry requirements.

#### Level 3 - 3 Advanced Level Subjects or Btec equivalents

5 GCSE's at grades A\* - C—preferably including English and Maths.

(D grades would be considered in certain circumstances )

# Level 2—Btec Sport Early Years, CACHE courses

In addition to these pathways, you will study

General RS

Maths or English GCSE resits. If you have not already passed these subjects with a 'C' grade.

Leadership Courses (e.g. Sports Leader, Literacy Leader, Numeracy Leader)

In your Year 11 Course Guidance interview, you will be given advice about which pathway is the most appropriate for you. This will be based on your Predicted grades and your GCSE mock examination results and will be confirmed when you receive your actual results in August and formally enrol in September for the year 12 courses.

When you move into Year 13 you will continue to follow a Level 3 pathway of either 3 or 4 subjects, depending on your AS/Btec results in Year 12. Level 2 students may choose to begin a Level 3 pathway.
